Subject: Reporting Work Hours under the National Maintenance Agreements

NMA signatory contractors are obligated to report work hours under the terms of Article XXVI Section 1 of the National Maintenance Agreement. Therefore, all work hours performed (including 'zero') need to be filed at www.NMAPC.org on a quarterly basis.

How to Report Work Hours:

- 1. Visit www.NMAPC.org;
- 2. Click "Report Work Hours," located in the second yellow navigation row;
- 3. The next screen will require you to login;
 - Enter your username and password;
 - Contact 703.841.9707 if you need this information;
- 4. The next screen will be the Work Hours Reporting dashboard;

To Report Work Hours Performed:

- Click the blue "Report Work Hours" button next to the active Site Extension Request (SER) for which you would like to report hours:
- In the next screen choose a reporting period (quarter or month and year);
- Then report hours next to each craft by putting in the total number of hours that each craft worked (you can only report for crafts that approved the SER);
 - Click the blue "File Hours" button located at the bottom of the page;
 - At the bottom only select "**Project Completed**" *if* all work at that site is completed, this will move it from the "Active" to the "Completed" section.
- If you do not see a site/project that you need to report hours for, then you need to file a SER, which when approved, will then give you a place to report hours.

To Report Zero Hours (Reporting Zero is only necessary for **Active** projects):

- Click the blue "Report Zero Hours" button located next to the active SER on the work hours page that you need to report Zero hours under;
- In the window choose a reporting period and project status and click "submit."
